Guidelines for Preparing Team Biographies

Each student and coach on the team must write a short biography, **in third person**, to be included in the National Science Bowl Program.

Remember: **THIRD PERSON!**

There should be **no** mentions of the following words:

me ~ we ~ I ~ our ~ my

The following is a list of interesting details that can be included in the biographies.

Students:

- ~ Interests and hobbies
- ~ Favorite classes
- ~ Future plans for college and career
- ~ Interesting facts about yourself

Coaches:

- ~ Subjects taught
- ~ Hobbies and Interests
- ~ Length of time as a teacher
- ~ Colleges attended and areas of study
- ~ Interesting facts about yourself

A few notes:

- 1) If there are two coaches for the team, the two coaches share the space in the coach field. We are limited in total characters and do not want to take space away from the students.
- 2) Do not include the name of your school – the school name will be posted at the top of each team’s page.
- 3) Try to include the grade level of the student in the biography.
- 4) Please begin each biography with the student’s first and last name (same for the coach). For example, “Minnie Mouse is a sixth grade student whose favorite classes are math and science...”
