

[New Proposals Seeking FY2018 Funding for Research](#)

Dear Member of the Nuclear Science Community:

As part of its continuing effort to ensure a U.S. nuclear science research program of the highest quality and impact, the Physics Research Division of the DOE Office of Nuclear Physics (NP) is announcing that new proposals seeking FY2018 funding for research need to be submitted by September 30, 2017, in order to receive full consideration. New proposals are applications for funding to create a new research grant, or an existing award that proposes new scope of work. A new co-PI faculty staff joining an existing NP supported group will also be required to submit a new proposal for consideration. Proposals for renewal of an existing award which do not involve new scope of work will be processed and peer reviewed normally according to their project expiration dates.
